Claims of ₹25,160 cr settled under Jan Suraksha in 11 yrs

JANSURAKSHA SCHEMES LIKE Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana and Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana have settled claims of about ₹25,160 crore since their launch in 2015, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Saturday.

Jan Suraksha schemes Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY), and Atal Pension Yojana (APY) envisioned to extend affordable financial protection to all, particularly the under-served and vulnerable sections of society, were launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on May 9, 2015.

These flagship schemes, which completed 11 years, aim to broaden the insurance and pension landscape by shielding citizens against life's uncertainties and fostering long-term financial resilience.

Citing data on the 11th anniversaries of the Jan Suraksha Schemes, Sitharaman said that over 270 million, 580 million and 90 million enrolments have been done under PMJJBY, PMSBY and APY, respectively.

On PMJJBY, she said the scheme has settled claims worth more than ₹21,500 crore for over 1.07 million families.

Under PMSBY scheme, Sitharaman said it has settled claims worth nearly ₹3,660 crore for over 184,000 families.

"As we mark the 11th anniversary of the Jan Suraksha schemes, heartfelt appreciation for all the stakeholders, including field functionaries of banks and insurance companies, whose dedicated efforts have made these schemes a huge success," she said.

Minister of State for Finance Pankaj Chaudhary said the launch of the online Jan Surak-

sha Portal has made it possible for citizens to enrol conveniently without visiting bank branches or post offices, and the digitising the claims process has ensured faster settlements, enabling timely support to bereaved families when they need it the most.

Launched in 2015, PMJJBY offers life insurance cover for death due to any cause at an annual premium of ₹436. Eligible individuals between 18 and 50 years can enrol through participating banks or post offices. It provides ₹2 lakh to the nominee in the event of the subscriber's death.

The PMSBY scheme offers accidental death and disability

insurance to individuals aged 18 to 70 years at a nominal premium of ₹20 per annum. The scheme pays ₹2 lakh for accidental death or total disability and ₹1 lakh for partial disability.

Atal Pension Yojana aims to provide old-age income security to unorganised sector workers. It guarantees a monthly pension of ₹1,000 to ₹5,000 after the age of 60, depending on the contribution.

Open to bank account holders aged 18 to 40 years who are not income tax payers, the scheme has seen over 76.6 million enrolments till April 2025.

As on April 30, more than 90.4 million individuals have enrolled in the scheme, it added.

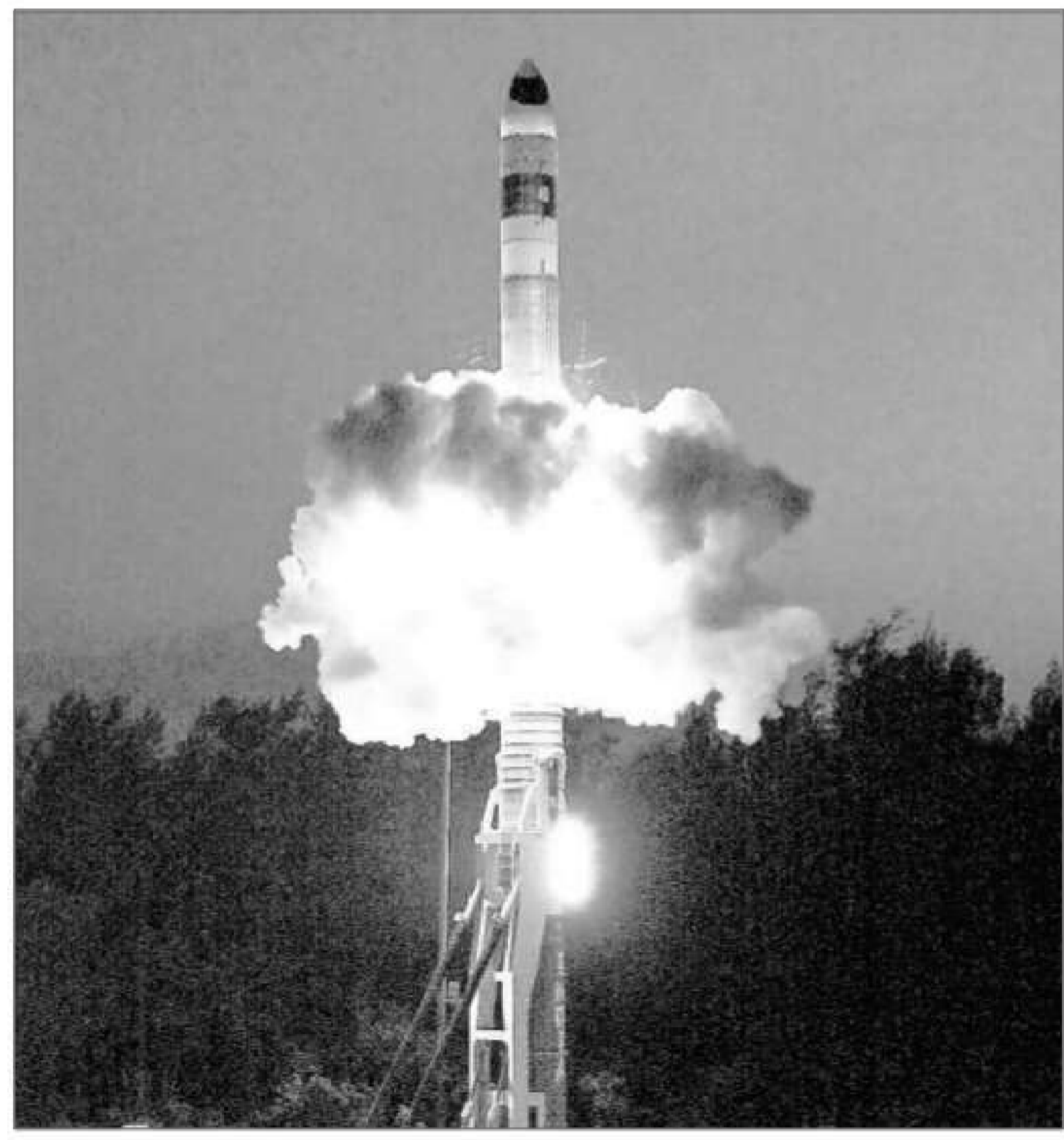

Reliance ADAG cases: CBI searches at 17 premises

THE CBI ON Saturday conducted searches at 17 premises in Mumbai in connection with three cases registered against Reliance ADA Group companies — Reliance Telecom, Reliance Commercial Finance and Reliance Home Finance and their directors, officials said.

"These searches are being conducted at the residential premises of directors of the above-mentioned companies as well as at the office premises of intermediary companies whose accounts were used for diversion of bank funds," a spokesperson for the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) said in a statement.

No immediate reaction was available from the companies. The CBI got a search warrant issued from a special court in Mumbai on Friday. The searches have led to the seizure of incriminating documents, the officials said.

is ₹27,337 crore, they added. "Searches have also revealed that multiple intermediary companies were operating from same address. The investigation is continuing," the statement said.

The federal agency has lodged seven cases against the Anil Ambani-led Reliance Group based on complaints from various public sector banks and the LIC in connection with alleged frauds involving thousands of crores of rupees. The CBI had conducted searches at 14 locations in the last few months, immediately after the registra-

tion of these cases. The agency has arrested two senior executives of RCom — Joint President D Vishwanath, who was the overall in-charge of the group's banking operations, and vice-president Anil Kalya, who had actively supported Vishwanath in managing the banking operations and payments and utilisation of funds — on April 24.

"Both the accused persons are presently in judicial custody. The investigation into the cases relating to the Anil Ambani-led Reliance Group is being monitored by the Supreme Court," the statement said.

CCI probe into Pernod's dealing with retailers

ANTITRUST WATCHDOG COMPETITION Commission of India (CCI) on Friday ordered an investigation into French liquor group Pernod Ricard over alleged exclusive deals with retailers to promote its brands at the expense of rivals, a regulatory order showed. The CCI has been reviewing allegations since 2024 that Pernod, whose brands include Chivas Regal and Absolut vodka, colluded with retailers in New Delhi to boost its market share.

The complaint alleges that Pernod provided \$24 million in corporate guarantees to its bankers in 2021 to help city retailers secure loans, with retailers in turn ensuring 35% of the stock in their shops comprised Pernod brands.

The CCI said it found merit in the allegations, noting in its order that "the non-dealing in the product of the competitors ... is likely to result in distortion of demand by way of moving

retail demand away from the competing brands." In a statement on Saturday, Pernod told Reuters it "unequivocally denies any wrongdoing" and will cooperate with the CCI if the authorities contact the company.

"We operate to the highest standards of compliance and governance, and we are confident that our business practices fully adhere to the laws and regulations of the country. We view any allegations to the contrary as without merit," it said in a statement.

The allegations were made by an individual identified only by the first name Mohit, who has a record of taking up public interest litigations. The case adds to challenges for Pernod in India, its largest market by sales volume. The company competes with Diageo among others in the market and reported sales of ₹27,445 crore in 2024-25.

A Pernod India office was raided in 2024 in a separate antitrust case.

Minister Jitendra Singh to attend nuclear energy innovation summit for Africa virtually

RWANDA HAS OFFICIALLY invited Union minister Jitendra Singh to participate in the Nuclear Energy Innovation Summit for Africa (NEISA 2026) scheduled to be held in Kigali from May 18 to May 21.

"Dr Jitendra Singh, however, regretted his inability to visit Rwanda personally but agreed to participate virtually and address the designated session during the summit," an official said. The invitation was extended during a meeting between Jacqueline Mukangira, Rwanda's High Commissioner to India, and Singh on Saturday. The summit — being organised in collaboration with leading international and regional institutions including the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) and United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA) — is expected to bring together policymakers, scientists, innovators, industry leaders and strategic stakeholders to deliberate on nuclear energy innovation, AI integration, manufacturing ecosystems. —PTI

FIFA to hold three separate World Cup opening ceremonies

FIFA ANNOUNCED ON Friday that it will hold separate opening ceremonies prior to the first game in each of the three host countries for this year's World Cup, which is being held in Mexico, Canada and the US.

The biggest World Cup in history kicks off on June 11 in Mexico City, where Grammy Award-winning Mexican pop band Mana will be performing as part of a lineup that also includes Alejandro Fernandez and Belinda, FIFA said in a post on X.

The Mexico City concert will highlight Mexican culture and include Indigenous and "modern folkloric" performers, FIFA said. Canadian singers Alanis Morissette, Michael Buble, Alessia Cara, William Prince and Bangladeshi American

Sanjoy, who is a Los Angeles-based DJ, will perform ahead of Canada's opening group stage match against Bosnia and Herzegovina in Toronto on June 12.

FIFA said a "mosaic-inspired reimagining of the FIFA World Cup Trophy will reflect

The World Cup kicks off on June 11 in Mexico City, where Grammy Award-winning Mexican pop band Mana will perform

Canada's diversity and community" at the concert. Later that day, American singer-songwriter Katy Perry will headline an opening ceremony ahead of the US team's match against Paraguay in Los Angeles, where Atlanta rap star Nayvadius Wilburn, better known as Future, will also perform. The lineup also includes Anitta, LISA, Rema and Tyla.

The US concert is designed around "delivering a high-energy spectacle that reflects the scale, ambition and cultural power of the tournament itself," FIFA said.

Rules under labour codes notified

THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT on Friday notified the final rules under the four labour codes, bringing into force a unified framework aimed at modernising labour regulations, ensuring minimum wages, and extending universal social security to all workers.

The four codes — the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Code on Social Security, 2020; and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 — came into effect on November 21. However, their full implementation required the framing of rules. The Ministry of Labour and Employment had published draft rules on December 30 for stakeholder feedback, which were subsequently notified following legal vetting. Since labour is a concurrent subject under the Constitution, both the Centre and the states are required to notify rules for the nationwide enforcement of the four codes.

The new framework introduces several worker-friendly measures, including the mandatory issuance of appointment letters, free annual health check-ups for workers aged 40 and above, and equal pay, work, and opportunities for women, including provisions allowing them to work across different shifts. It also caps weekly working hours

at 48, mandates at least one weekly day of rest, and requires overtime payment for additional hours worked.

The Industrial Relations Code also provides for the establishment of a National Reskilling Fund to support workers who lose their jobs due to technological or economic changes. According to Rule 37 of the Industrial Relations (Central) Rules, 2026, every employer who has laid off a worker in an industrial establishment must contribute an amount equivalent to 15 days' salary of the employee to the reskilling fund within 10 days of the layoff.

The rules under the Occu-

pational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code address working hours, overtime, contract labour obligations, mandatory appointment letters, and annual medical examinations for specified workers, with a focus on strengthening workplace safety outcomes. The new rules mandate that workers are entitled to overtime wages at twice the normal rate ("double wages") for work exceeding eight hours a day for daily-rated workers, or 48 hours a week for others. Overtime must be paid at the end of each wage period, with fractions of an hour rounded to 30 minutes or a full hour.

Employers are prohibited from requiring any worker to perform more than 144 hours of overtime in any quarter of the year. They must also maintain detailed electronic or manual records of overtime hours and payments in the prescribed register, while wage slips must separately mention overtime wages.

Puneet Gupta, partner, People Advisory Services - Tax, EY India, said the notification of the Central Rules across all four labour codes marks a critical transition from legislative intent to on-ground implementation. The Central Rules framed under three of the codes — the Code on Wages,

the Industrial Relations Code, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code — will predominantly apply to establishments for which the Central government is the "appropriate government".

"This includes sectors such as telecommunications, banking and insurance, mines, oil fields, major ports, air transport, as well as central public sector undertakings and their contractors. In contrast, the Central Rules under the Code on Social Security have a much wider footprint and will extend to establishments operating across more than one state," he said.

Gupta noted that the rules are also likely to influence state-level frameworks. "Notably, these final Central Rules are expected to serve as the foundation for states to frame and operationalise their respective State Rules under the labour codes. The practical impact of these rules for most organisations, especially under the three codes, will depend on the extent to which State Rules mirror the Central framework," he added.

Under the Code on Social Security, the rules provide procedural clarity on the registration of gig and platform workers, crèche facilities, ESI contributions, and nominations, while promoting a digital, platform-driven approach to expand coverage and improve transparency.
